**Baptism:** Parents requesting Baptism for their child(ren) should contact Fr. Teddy at least three months in advance of their desired date.

**First Holy Communion:** Parents who wish to present their child(ren) (under 16) for first Holy Communion during 2024 should contact the parish office) no later than Friday 26 January 2024. For older children and adults, contact Fr Teddy directly.

**Confirmation**: Parents, with children under 16 years of age who request Confirmation, should contact Fr Teddy, and those over the age of 16 should contact Fr Teddy direct, for Confirmation during 2025.

**Marriage**: Those who wish to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage in St Anne's Parish should contact Fr Teddy direct at least twelve months prior to their desired date. They should not make any final plans until they have done this.

**Information about the Catholic Faith**. Those wishing to explore the Catholic Faith and who may wish to become members of the Catholic Community should contact Fr Teddy.

**Sacrament of the Sick** (formerly known as The Last Rites).
