Message from Fr Damian: The readings for this Sunday highlight Jesus' healing power and the themes of serving others, hope, and evangelization. Job's lamentation in the first reading contrasts with the psalm's reminder of God's ability to heal the broken-hearted, In the Gospel reading, we see a profound example of responding to God's grace. When Jesus heals Simon's mother-in-law, who was gravely ill, her immediate reaction is to serve those around her. In a time when illness was often life-threatening due to the lack of modern medicine, her recovery is miraculous. Yet, she doesn't focus on herself. Instead, she turns her gratitude into action, serving Jesus and others. This passage invites us to reflect on our own responses to God's grace. Are we like Simon's mother-in-law, channelling our gratitude into acts of service and love?
