"The Paschal Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of the Lord begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, has its centre in the Easter Vigil, and closes with vespers of the Sunday of the Resurrection. The Easter fast is sacred on the first two days of the Triduum, in which, according to an ancient tradition, the Church fasts "because the Spouse has been taken away"

Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence; it is also recommended that Holy Saturday be so observed, so that the Church, with uplifted and welcoming heart, be ready to celebrate the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection" (Ordo)

Please do your very best to celebrate the Sacred Triduum beginning with Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday evening. This year we are again celebrating the event with the one Mass on Maundy Thursday and the one celebration of the Easter Vigil, both at Our Lady's. I hope there will be a good representation of both parishes at each Mass. On Good Friday Msgr McHugh will be at Shipston and I shall be at Kineton for the 3.00pm service. You are also asked to bring your bells to ring for the **First Mass of Easter on Holy Saturday evening** (8.00pm). There will be wine and (hopefully canapes) for the celebration in the parish hall after Mass. This will be a lovely opportunity for parishioners from the three places of worship and two parishes, to combine and celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord together.
