Welcome toyou all and Happy Feast of St. Patrick. Lent moves into its final and most solemn weeks today, and we start hearing in the readings to come that the only people He wants to stay with are His disciples and closest friends such Mary, Martha, and their brother Lazarus. To others, He wants to be unseen or hidden. This message is also a nice invitation for us to join Him and become either one of his disciples or a very close friend. Just reflect today how that could happen. 'The days are coming' God tells us through Jeremiah' when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel' and so today we hear Jesus again speaking of being 'lifted up from the earth', describing the way in which that new covenant will be initiated. That new covenant will give glory to God for it is on the altar of the Cross that Christ's victory is won. Christ will again be lifted up from the earth when, risen and ascended He returns to His heavenly glory. Yes, the Father's will is done and He is glorified but the Paschal mystery of Christ's death, resurrection and Ascension restores us to glory too.

## This week's Gospel - John 12:20-33

# 'If a grain of wheat falls on the ground and dies, it yields a rich harvest'

Among those who went up to worship at the festival were some Greeks. These approached Philip, who came from Bethsaida in Galilee, and put this request to him, 'Sir, we should like to see Jesus.' Philip went to tell Andrew, and Andrew and Philip together went to tell Jesus. Jesus replied to them:

'Now the hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. I tell you, most solemnly, unless a wheat grain falls on the ground and dies, it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, it yields a rich harvest. Anyone who loves his life loses it; anyone who hates his life in this world will keep it for the eternal life. If a man serves me, he must follow me, wherever I am, my servant will be there too. If anyone serves me, my Father will honour him. Now my soul is troubled. What shall I say: Father, save me from this hour? But it was for this very reason that I have come to this hour. Father, glorify your name!' A voice came from heaven, 'I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again.' People standing by, who heard this, said it was a clap of thunder; others said, 'It was an angel speaking to him.' Jesus answered, 'It was not for my sake that this voice came, but for yours. 'Now sentence is being passed on this world; now the prince of this world is to be overthrown. And when I am lifted up from the earth, I shall draw all men to myself.'

By these words he indicated the kind of death he would die.
