Message from Fr Damian. Divine Mercy Sunday: The readings for Divine Mercy Sunday show us that the mercy of God is given to all of us, even though we turn away again and again. In the gospel for this Sunday Jesus appears to the disciples, but Thomas is not there. A week later, Jesus appears again, and this time Thomas is there. Jesus comes back and lovingly helps Thomas overcome his doubts, he invites Thomas to touch his wounds and to believe. Thomas responds with a powerful declaration of faith: "My Lord and my God!"

When Thomas doubts, Jesus does not rebuke him or shame him. He simply offers him the evidence he needs to believe and invites him into a deeper relationship.

This is a powerful message for us today. We all have moments of doubt and fear, times when we struggle to believe or to trust in God's plan for us. But like Thomas, we are invited to bring our doubts and questions to Jesus, who offers us peace and the evidence we need to believe. A huge thank you to you all for your generous easter offering. It is very much appreciated.

Lepra is a UK-registered international charity changing the lives of people affected by disease, poverty and prejudice. With a history spanning over 100 years. They work on the frontline in India and Bangladesh to treat, educate, rehabilitate and give a voice to people living on the margins of society. They focus on people who find themselves trapped at the intersection of disease, poverty and prejudice and help them to improve their health, lives and livelihoods.
