Message from Fr Damian. Fifth Sunday of Easter. Our readings this weekend, remind us of our dependence on God and each other. In the Gospel, Jesus described himself as the true vine and his Father as the gardener. Branches not bearing fruit are removed, while fruitful ones are pruned for more yield. He emphasized staying connected to him, akin to branches on a vine, as the key to bearing fruit. Without him, nothing can be achieved. Unfruitful branches are discarded. Fruitfulness in believers brings glory to God and proves discipleship. The second reading also echoes this teaching. In our parish, we are always looking for parishioners to be the branches to spread and grow our parish. If you can help please talk to me.

Message from Archbishop Bernard: I want to let you know directly, and as the Holy See announced on 25th April, that the Holy Father has appointed Mgr Timothy Menezes and Canon Richard Walker as Auxiliary Bishops for the Archdiocese. I know that you will join me in assuring them both of our prayers as they prepare to take up their new responsibilities for the pastoral care of our clergy and people.

CAFOD Emergency Sudan Appeal. The situation in Sudan is deteriorating rapidly and with 25 million people needing immediate humanitarian assistance up to seven million people will now be at risk of famine-like conditions by June.CAFOD is supporting their local partners.
