Easter Duty: As a Precept of the Church, 'Easter Duty' draws the Catholic faithful directly into the heart of the Paschal Mystery, hence the importance of Eucharistic reception during the Easter season (ordinarily Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday). Although most Catholics receive Holy Communion frequently throughout the year including Eastertime, Easter Duty sets the minimum obligation and expectations for those who do not.

Month of May is traditionally observed as 'Month of Mary'. There will be a formal beginning of May devotions at the beginning of the month and another to conclude at the end of the month.
