Easter Duty: As a Precept of the Church, 'Easter Duty' draws the Catholic faithful directly into the heart of the Paschal Mystery, hence the importance of Eucharistic reception during the Easter season (ordinarily Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday). Although most Catholics receive Holy Communion frequently throughout the year including Eastertime, Easter Duty sets the minimum obligation and expectations for those who do not.

Month of May is traditionally observed as 'Month of Mary'. There will be a formal beginning of May devotions on Wednesday 1st May and another to conclude on Friday 31st May.

Rosary is prayed before Masses, particularly during the month of May and October in many parishes. We need volunteers to lead the Rosary. Anyone willing to help, please let Fr. Arul know.
