This year's theme is "Speaking with the heart- The truth in love" In his message to mark the day, Pope Francis stresses the need to listen before speaking truth with a pure heart to "see beyond appearances and overcome the vague din which in the field of information, does not help us to discern in the complicated world in which we live" The Holy Father, warning against indifference and indignation, hails the example of the great Doctor of the Church, St Francis de Sales, in particular his commitment to patient, heartfelt dialogue. A gifted theologian, his phrase 'heart speaks to heart' inspired many, none more so than Saint John Henry Newman, who chose as his cardinalatial motto 'Cor ad cor loquitur' (Bishop John Arnold)
