Message from Fr Damian. Sixth Sunday of Easter. The readings for this weekend focus on love and inclusion. They show that God's love is for everyone. God welcomes everyone into His family. The readings also emphasize that love is central to knowing God because God is love. Jesus tells us to love each other as He has loved us, which is key to following Him. He explains that the greatest love involves sacrifice, like His sacrifice for us. Jesus also calls us friends, not just followers, showing a deep, personal relationship with us. He promises to answer our prayers, reinforcing our trust in His care. These readings remind us that love is at the heart of our Christian life.
