The Pope's Prayer Intention: We pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys full of danger and violence, find welcome and new opportunities in the countries that receive them.

Fr Frank: St Paul, in our second reading today, tells us that, "For anyone who is in Christ, there is a new creation: the old creation has gone, and now the new one is here." St John in his Gospel puts it like this: "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born anew, he cannot see the kingdom of God." Those in Christ have been given the power to be children of God, because they have been re-born, created anew, born from above - born not by natural generation, nor by human choice, nor by man's decision, but of God. Such is the nature of our supernatural life in Christ - a life which is a light to the world. A life we need to nurture if we are to be effective in evangelisation and mission.
