Year of Prayer 2024 and The Jubilee Year 2025: In preparation for the 2025 Jubilee Year 'Pilgrims of Hope', 2024 has been designated a Year of Prayer by Pope Francis "first of all, to recover the desire to be in the presence of the Lord, to listen to him and adore him." We are invited to be aware of the centrality of individual and community prayer during this year.

There is a particular focus on the *Our Father*, and this presents us with a great opportunity to go back to the basics of prayer.

The websites of our diocese and that of the Bishops' Conference of England & Wales offer further help on this.

In our parish, the Bible Study Group are currently devoting their study and reflections on this topic. All are welcome.

Adoremus in Our Parish- Sunday 15 September: The Catholic Church in England and Wales - bishops, priests and people from all dioceses - will gather at St Mary's College, Oscott, on Saturday 14 September for a day to renew and deepen our devotion to the Eucharist

St Mary's College was the venue for the first Eucharistic Procession since the Reformation.

Unlike Adoremus in Liverpool in 2018, this is not a public event, although each diocese will send pilgrims.

On Sunday 15 September, the Bishops of England and Wales invite all parishes across our countries to have a period of Exposition to unite the faithful in focusing on the Eucharist in anticipation of the Jubilee Year with renewed and deepened devotion.

This can be a Holy Hour or a period of prayer in front of the Blessed Sacrament. We'll reflect on how this could be done in our parish.
