The generosity of God is increased in Jesus who feeds thousands, and yet that generosity is misunderstood. The crowds try to make Jesus their king by force. But Jesus' kingship is on His terms, not ours and cannot be created by force. The ultimate generosity of Christ on the Cross reveals a King reigning in what seems to be weakness but is actually in eternal triumph. His generosity is unbounded, just like His triumph but it

ARRANGING A WEDDING

Congratulations on your engagement! To arrange a wedding, an initial meeting with Fr Stephen is vital so that the canonical and civil processes can be correctly followed. Couples need to give at least six months' notice.

ARRANGING A BAPTISM

Congratulations on the birth of your baby! First, parents must begin the process by seeing Fr Stephen *in person* at a Sunday Mass. He can then check a few simple facts and give out a baptism application form. We do not deal with initial arrangements by phone, email or through other members of the family, but face to face. Parents need to attend a preparation session before the baptism can take place.
