Message from Fr Damian. The readings for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time are a call to listen to God and follow Him even when those around us do not. Feast of St Benedict. Thursday 11th July: We have moved our evening mass to Thursday Night this week to celebrate our Parish Patronal Feast of St Benedict. Advent 2024 New Lectionaries. Although a few years ago we bought some new Lectionaries, Sadly from Advent this year the Church in England and Wales will be using a new translation of the Bible and a new version of some of the prayers and responses. All churches will have to use the new version from Advent 2024 the old books will no longer be in use. This new translation of the lectionary from the English Standard Version, Catholic Edition (ESVCE), is to be used in all churches. We have preordered the Ambo edition of the Lectionaries. They come as a set of four volumes they cost around £175 each but with a preorder discount are reduced to £145.25 each. We have also ordered the new book of the gospels which was £275 with a preorder discount is now £233.75. Ordination of Auxiliary Bishops: The episcopal ordination of Mgr. Timothy Menezes and Canon Richard Walker as auxiliary bishops of the Archdiocese of Birmingham will take place at noon on Tuesday 16th July at St. Chad's Cathedral. Due to limitations on space, the Mass of Ordination is by invitation only, but all are welcome to join online via the cathedral's live stream facility. The booklet for the Ordination will be available on the website and it is hoped it will also be recorded.

Banbury & Warwick Deanery. At the First meeting of the Deanery Pastoral Council (DPC) meeting on Wed 8th May 2024, over 40 lay representatives and parish priests/ deacons met for the first meeting in Bicester. The minutes are on the Deanery website. The main agenda item was around the grouping of the parishes into 5 possible clusters, known as Leamington, Rugby, Bicester & Banbury, Stratford and Kenilworth. It was agreed that the representatives of the parishes on the Deanery PC should meet with the parish priests before the next meeting on 19th September, to discuss the proposed clusters, recommend any improvements and share how parishes within the cluster can support each other in fulfilling the Diocesan Vision.
