**Message from Fr Damian.** The readings for this weekend focus on God's care and generosity. In the first reading, Elisha feeds a hundred people with twenty loaves, showing God's ability to provide. In the Gospel, Jesus feeds five thousand with a boy's small offering of bread and fish, highlighting the power of generosity and God's miraculous provision.

Paul's letters to the Ephesians urge us to live in unity, being humble, gentle, and patient, reflecting God's love. These readings remind us to trust God with what we have, live in harmony, and see the Eucharist as a sign of Jesus' care for us.

This Weekend World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. This weekend is the closest to the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary's Parents, Ss Joachim and Anne. In his message, Pope Francis for this day of Prayer highlights the verse from Psalm 71 that depicts the plea of an elderly person who reflects on the story of their friendship with God. "Do not cast me off in my old age", We would welcome your grandparents or elderly neighbours or friends to join us this weekend.

Annual Pilgrimage to Harvington Hall, Sunday 1 September. The pilgrimage to the Shrine of the English Martyrs will take place on Sunday 1<sup>St</sup> September: Mass is at 3 pm with Confessions from 1.45 pm to 2.30 pm. The Right Reverend Paul Gunter OSB, Abbot of Douai Abbey will be the principal celebrant. Free tours of Harvington Hall are available to pilgrims on the day and can be booked upon arrival. There is free parking available. You must bring your own chairs and a packed lunch if needed.

**Lectionaries.** Although a few years ago we bought some new Lectionaries, Sadly from Advent this year the Church in England and Wales will be using a new translation of the Bible and a new version of some of the prayers and responses. All churches will have to use the new version from Advent 2024 the old books will no longer be in use. This new translation of the lectionary from the English Standard Version, Catholic Edition (ESVCE), is to be used in all churches. We have preordered the Ambo edition of the Lectionaries. They come as a set of four volumes they cost around £175 each but with a preorder discount are reduced to £145.25 each. We have also ordered the new book of the gospels which was £275 with a preorder discount is now £233.75.
