It is early days yet but an embryonic Deanery Pastoral Council has been formed. Parishes are encouraged to have some form of parish council. We need to address this in our own two parishes. We are about to form a Cluster with our neighbouring parishes; St Maries, Our Lady and St Wulstan Southam and St Anne's Wappenbury (inc Princethorpe) to see what we can do locally.
