Livestreaming Consent Forms: As mentioned at Mass
last weekend the rules on livestreaming have changed.
A consent form is required to be completed by anyone

themselves. Videos will only be available for 3 months,
but if for whatever reason you wish to make the video
available for longer, signed consent is also required and
