National Eucharistic Pilgrimage and Congress –

Sept 2024: Weekend of 14/15 September. The Catholic Church in England and Wales - bishops, priests and people from all dioceses - will gather at St Mary's College, Oscott, to renew and deepen devotion to the Eucharist. St Mary's College was the venue for the first Eucharistic Procession since the Reformation. Unlike Adoremus in Liverpool in 2018, this is not a public event, although each diocese will send pilgrims. Over the weekend, the Bishops of England and Wales invite all parishes to have a period of Exposition to unite the faithful in focusing on the Eucharist in anticipation of the Jubilee Year with renewed and deepened devotion.
