Date for Diary: Quiz Night at St Francis: Kineton Hall- Saturday 6th October.

On Monday we celebrate the feast of Blessed Dominic Barberi: "He was born near Viterbo, Italy. He entered the Passionists and was ordained priest in 1818. He taught theology in Rome and served as a Provincial. He had long believed that he had been called to be an instrument for the conversion of England and in his final years was given the opportunity of labouring tirelessly in this country, despite facing much opposition. On 8th October 1845 he received Blessed John Henry Newman into the Church at Littlemore" (Ordo)
