Looking ahead...Sunday 1 December is the First Sunday of Advent and we will be using the new Lectionary and new Mass books. Those who use their own Missal should order the new version now to be ready in time!

Important! The Catholic Bishops have asked all Catholics to write to their MP objecting to the proposed Bill of assisted suicide going through Parliament. This change in the law would bring great pressure onto the elderly and the disabled to " do the right thing" which is the wrong thing as it violates the sacredness of human life as much as abortion. There are notices at the back of church but it is possible to contact your MP direct.

In November we pray with Pope Francis that all parents who mourn the loss of a son or daughter find support in their community and receive peace and consolation from the Holy Spirit.

November is the month we remember those we have loved and lost. The book of Remembrance will be placed at the back of the Church for you to note the names of those you know who have died. There will also be envelopes for Mass Offerings.
