Readings for the Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time: This week's readings invite us to reflect on love, loyalty, and faithfulness. These themes are evident in the commands given in Deuteronomy, the eternal priesthood of Jesus in Hebrews, and Jesus' teaching on the greatest commandments in Mark. Jesus says we must love God fully and love our neighbours as ourselves. Jesus' perfect sacrifice shows us the way to approach God through love. True self-sacrifice, as seen in Jesus' death on the cross, is the love God desires. Jesus urges us to examine our hearts, ensuring nothing hinders our love for God and others. Loving our enemies and praying for those who oppose us are also essential.

The faint rays of winter sunshine added to the brightness of the festival."
