from the Holy Spirit.

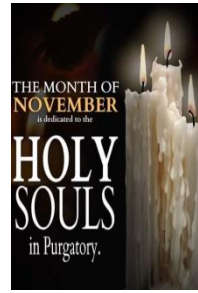


We remember in our prayers: The sick and

Take Action! Assisted Suicide Bill Resources: The
