Road Closure from Monday 24th February Rising Lane will be completely closed for 11 days from Netherwood lane (Baddesley Clinton Hall NT) to the canal. Parishioners from Lapworth and Hockley Heath will need to take a detour: If you travel along Chessets Wood Road (From the Punch Bowl) towards Darley Green, turn right into Chapel Lane and continue to the "T" junction. Turn right into Bakers Lane and continue to the "T" junction with the Warwick Road. Turn right and continue to Chadwick End. After passing through the village turn right into Rising Lane, St Francis of Assisi church is on the right after approximately a quarter of a mile.
