Readings for the Fourth Sunday in Lent: The readings for this Sunday remind us of God's mercy. They show us the



importance of seeking forgiveness and offering it to others. They encourage us to embrace God's love and to live as new creations in Christ.

In the Gospel we have the parable of the prodigal Son. This parable encourages us to reflect on our own lives. Are we seeking freedom without responsibility, or are we dutiful without love? Let us strive to find balance, motivated by love, as we follow God's example of mercy and forgiveness.

This Sunday is Mothering Sunday "Laetare Sunday". The Church celebrates this Sunday in the middle of Lent as Hope and Joy Sunday. It is Mothering Sunday, and Catholics are encouraged to visit both their mothers and their spiritual mother

church. We pray for all Mothers and Grandmothers and thank God for the part played by all the ladies of our parish. We thank God for our mothers, both living and departed and for our Spiritual Mother Mary and for our Church
