Seek Justice, says the Lord ... We are called to be fruitful in our lives, just like the fig tree in today's gospel. ## This Week's Gospel - Luke 13:1-9

'Unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.'

There were some present at that very time who told Jesus about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. And he answered them, 'Do you think that these Galileans were worse sinners than all the other Galileans because they suffered in this way? No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish. Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them: do you think that they were worse offenders than all the others who lived in Jerusalem? No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.' And he told this parable: 'A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. And he said to the vine dresser, "Look, for three years now I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and I find none.

Cut it down. Why should it use up the ground?" And he answered him, "Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig round it and put on manure. Then if it should bear fruit next year, well and good; but if not, you can cut it down."

peacefully in Derryswood aged 99 (he would have been 100 in April). Fr Bill joined the Rosminians in 1941 devoting 83 years to religious life, teaching at Ratcliffe College, Leicestershire and in

Auckland, New Zealand. Returning to the UK to the parishes of St. Alban's Cardiff, Our Lady of Lourdes Swansea, St Joseph Neath and as Chaplain at RAF St. Athan's, retiring in 2008 to Derryswood. His Funeral will be held at Derryswood on
