CHRIST IS RISEN! ALLELUIA!ALLELUIA! ALLELUIA!

<u>WELCOME TO MASS</u>, as we celebrate the triumph of Jesus, risen from the dead! Alleluia! Easter Day is the cornerstone of our faith in the love and mercy of God, sharing with us the human experience of suffering and death but also offering us the divine experience of resurrection and eternal life.

So Easter begins after Sunset on Saturday evening, when the new fire is kindled and the Paschal Candle lit and solemnly taken into church. Each of us has a candle too and the Easter fire is passed from one to another as the light grows. The great Easter hymn of praise to the resurrection is sung and then we listen to Scripture reminding us of our need of God's salvation and His willingness to provide it. The solemn **Alleluia!** Is proclaimed, and we celebrate a baptism this year and renew our own baptismal promises that united us to the death and resurrection of Jesus. Two confirmations follow and then joyfully we celebrate Mass and Christ returns to the tabernacle, back with His people. It is glorious, moving and uplifting—just like what God offers to us, His people! **God bless us all this joyful Eastertide**. *Fr Stephen*
