THE WORD THIS WEEK

Jesus has reached Jerusalem: the goal of a journey which forms the biggest part of Luke's Gospel. The liturgy begins with the exuberant procession in which we are encouraged to acclaim in triumph 'Hosanna to the son of David!' It all changes after that. Today really is Passion Sunday; Jesus' sufferings are portrayed starkly today, not, as on Good Friday, as a triumph. Only found in Luke's passion account are the following: Jesus' forgiving attitude to the sleeping disciples; healing the high priest's servant's ear; Jesus looking at Peter after his denial; the trial before Herod; the daughters of Jerusalem; the 'good thief'. This is not a 'sad' day, though; it is the way to glory.
