The Word was made flesh... As we celebrate the triumph of Jesus, risen from the dead, we reflect on His presence in our lives, a presence that is not just among us, but within us in profound ways. The deepest of these is His presence in the Eucharist. We need this Eucharistic presence, and we receive it into ourselves, to the very core of our being, at the very least, once a week. But His presence doesn't stop there. We encounter Christ in many forms—when we enter into a church to pray, He is there, present in the gathering of the faithful, in the sacred space of worship. There is also a deep and genuine sense of Christ's presence in the gathered Church this is why the Church is called the Mystical Body of Christ. Another powerful way Jesus dwells within us is through the Word of God. The Bible is not just a book—it's the living and active Word, sharper than a double edged sword. It pierces soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and discerns the thoughts and intentions of the heart (Hebrews 4:12)). It speaks to us personally, inviting us to know and live the truths of Christ. And finally, there is His presence within each of us. We are reminded in today's Gospel that wherever we go, God goes with us, and whatever we do, we do together with Him. We are never alone. As we see in the readings Jesus is preparing his disciples for his return to the Father, He promises His peace, a peace that comes through the gift of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit is sent to teach us the truth and to unite believers in the peace that Christ offers. Yet, as we see in the early Church, this truth is not always welcomed. For those outside the faith, the truth may be unwanted, unpalatable or simply unbearable. It can be difficult to accept, and at times, it may be uncomfortable or even divisive. But the truth of Christ remains unchanged, whether he is loved or not, and the Spirit helps us to embrace it, living in it, and sharing it with others. May we cherish this divine presence in all its forms—the Eucharist, the Word, the Church,

and the Spirit—and allow it to transform our lives. Let us live in the peace of Christ, knowing that wherever we go, He goes with usand dwells among us!
