Come Holy Spirit... Being one—and remaining one—has always been a challenge in human life. Families that should be united often carry wounds; friendships sometimes break down; communities can slowly drift apart as the bonds that hold us together wear thin. Even within ourselves, there is tension: the pull of the world's distractions tugging against the call of the Gospel to live in harmony and love. It's no surprise, then, that before His Passion, Jesus prayed for His apostles - may they be effective witnesses in the Spirit to the power and glory of the Gospel, and so earnestly for unity among those who would believe in Him. His prayer was not merely a hope but a mission—one entrusted to each of us. We are called to make that priestly prayer a living reality: that we may be one, just as the Father and Son are one. The unity Jesus desires is not passive or abstract. It is dynamic and fruitful. It opens doors especially as we pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit. It is active and life-giving, opening hearts and minds to the power of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit does not dwell where there is chaos, division, or strife. He is the Spirit of peace and rests only where peace is welcomed. This peace begins within each of us, when we invite Christ to reign in our hearts and heal the wounds that keep us apart. From that inner peace flows a greater harmony—one that we can share with our families, our parish communities, and the wider world. Under the guidance of Pope Leo and the wisdom of our Church, may we grow ever closer to one another in faith, hope, and love. May our hearts be open to all Christians, embracing the fullness of the unity for which Jesus prayed so fervently. Lord, may we all be one—in your love, your peace, and your grace ...make us one!
