Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. This Sunday, 22nd June. On this day, we celebrate the gift to us of the of the Sacred Eucharist in the Mass. We renew our devotion to Our Blessed Lord Jesus, who shares his Body and Blood with us every time we are at Mass.

Feast of St Peter and St Paul: Next Sunday, we celebrate these two early apostles of the Church. We ask them to continue interceding for us to the Lord, and we pray for Pope Leo XIV, our descendant of St Peter as our Pope. The Second Collection will be for Peter's Pence, the fund which supports the Pope's charitable works and the needs of the universal Church.

Message from Fr. Damian. Corpus Christi. This weekend, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ celebrates the gift of the Eucharist, a central mystery of our faith. The readings remind us of Christ's love and how he offers himself to unite us with God and with one another. The Eucharist is the new covenant that Jesus made with us through his Body and Blood. It is a sign of God's love and faithfulness to his people. Every time we receive the Eucharist, we renew our relationship with God and remember his promise to be with us always.

It is a moment to reflect on his faithfulness and how we can live as part of his covenant. This includes loving others, staying faithful to God, and trusting in his care. The Eucharist invites us to deepen our faith and live in love and service.

Extraordinary Eucharist Ministers needed: On this feast of Corpus Christi, can I remind parishioners, we want to increase the number of Eucharistic Ministers available to help at our Sunday Masses. If you think you can help, please speak to Fr Damian.
