New Missals

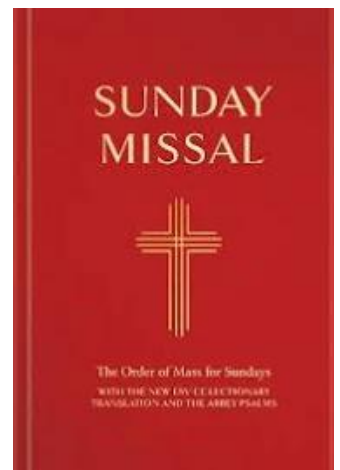
The order for more new Missals has been placed this week.
