Solemnity of Pentecost

They were all filled with the Holy Spirit... Welcome to Mass today as we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles and transformed their lives forever. Once they heard the Spirit stirring in their hearts, they couldn't keep it to themselves — they set out to share the Good News. They carried the Gospel far from Jerusalem, reaching as far as Spain, Ethiopia, and India. They weren't highly educated, wealthy, or powerful, but what they had was a deep, living, and contagious faith in Jesus. Pentecost reminds us that God hasn't just acted in the past—He is acting still. Through the Holy Spirit, He continues to equip His Church with the power it needs to love, serve, and proclaim Christ to the world. That same Spirit breaks down barriers: between language and culture, between sin and grace, between fear and courage. In the Spirit, we find the strength to respond to our calling, just as the Apostles did. We were blessed to witness a beautiful sign of this on Thursday, with Archbishop Bernard Longley as he celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation with our young people. It was a joyful and moving occasion, and a reminder that Pentecost continues. The same Spirit who came at that first Pentecost was poured out again upon those being confirmed. At Baptism we receive the Holy Spirit, and those confirmed have received a special outpouring of His gifts—gifts meant to be used in service of others. Today's feast invites each of us to listen to the Holy Spirit, and to allow our lives to speak the Gospel. Our words matter, but our actions often speak louder. As St Francis of Assisi said: "Preach the Gospel at all times; if necessary, use words." When we live with love, mercy, and truth, we become instruments through which others may begin to hear the Spirit too. Let us go forward from this Mass renewed in courage, and ready to share Christ—not only with our lips, but with our
