

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St Alban was the first British martyr. Almost nothing about him is known for certain – even the date of his martyrdom is unknown, and historians' estimates vary between 209 & 314 A.D. Alban was a Roman who lived in Verulamium and sheltered a fleeing Christian during a persecution. He was converted and was executed. His cult was already well established by the year 429, and on the hill where tradition said he was martyred, a great abbey grew up which eventually gave its name to the town.
